# 2.12 "As found" portion of the Device Examination Certificate

As you are aware, the "as found" portion of the Device Examination Certificate (DEC) is used to report the compliance status of a device when tested, before any adjustments or corrections are made.

You will notice section 2.12 of the updated Device Manual contains several important changes, most notably:

- a reduction in the number of as found codes for measurement errors from the previous eighteen to six (R1 to R3 and W1 to W3);
- the six as found codes for measurement errors (R1 to R3 and W1 to W3) are now preceded with an R or a W to indicate the direction of the error (same as the examination result codes) and a 1, 2 or 3 to indicate the magnitude of the error as compared to the applicable limit of error;
- the creation of two codes (RT and WT) for reporting automatic temperature compensator errors, again using an R or a W to indicate the direction of the error;
- a listing of all possible as found error codes, in descending order of importance, in a single table rather than two tables.
